### 2020 Home Sales

Ten homes within the Woodlands subdivision sold in 2020 with an average sale price of \$260,000. The highest home was sold for \$295,000 and the lowest was \$235,000. According to Zillow the typical home value of homes in the Omaha metro is \$213,210. Home values have gone up 7% over the past year (Oct. 2019 – Oct. 2020) and Zillow predicts they will rise nearly 6% in the next year.

# 2020 Activities

In 2020 we held neighborhood garage sales, rented a dumpster and got the roundabout looking good again. The dumpster was so popular the first one filled up in a day and then we rented a bigger one. We plan to do this again in the spring.

## 2021 Activities

We are proposing the following activities for 2021:

- Neighborhood garage sales no cost
- Shred event estimated at around \$200 if we partner with a neighboring subdivision
- Neighborhood clean-up cost \$400+ for a large dumpster
